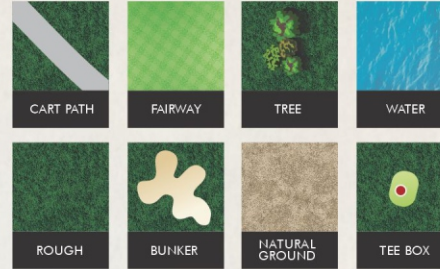

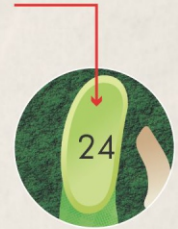

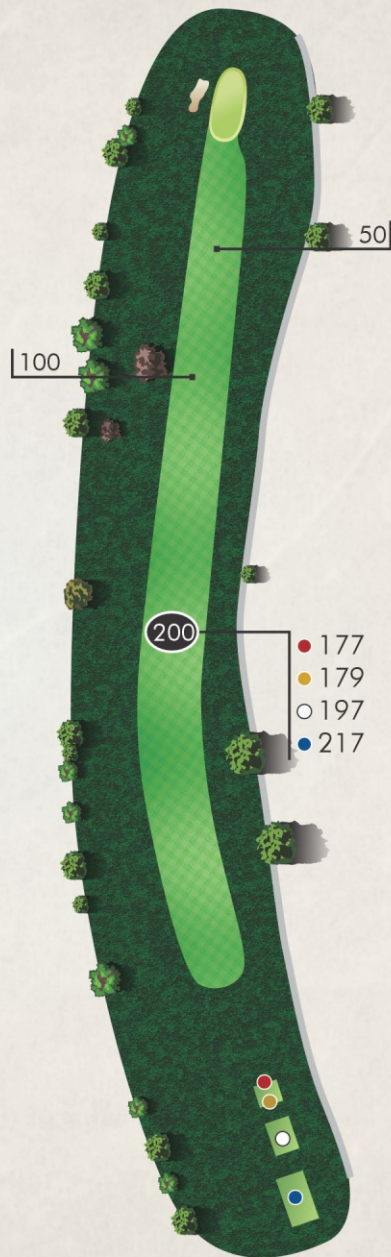
The distance from a point on the course to the center of the green. Generally you should aim to land your first shot here.

A generous landing area for the tee shot on this medium length par 4 gives way to an approach shot to a small, narrow green guarded by sand left and a grassy mound on the right. Par is a good score.

Arguably the toughest par 3 on the course. Some would say the toughest hole period. Uphill all the way to a green that slopes severely from back to front and left to right. Missing long or right is jail. A miss left leaves a tough up and down for par.

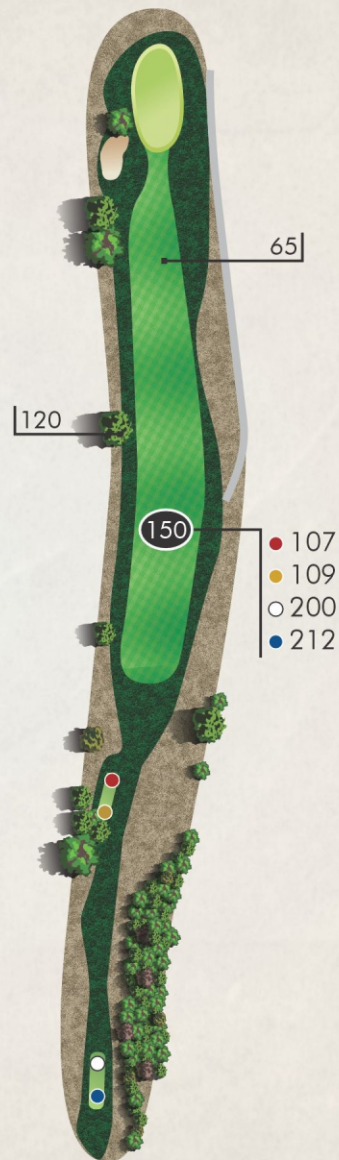

A short par 4 with a sharp set of teeth. It plays into the prevailing wind. Favor the right side off the tee since the fairway slants severely to the left. The hole runs along the rim of a hillside and any miss left can end up 100 yards down a steep slope. The green is long and narrow, guarded by sand left.

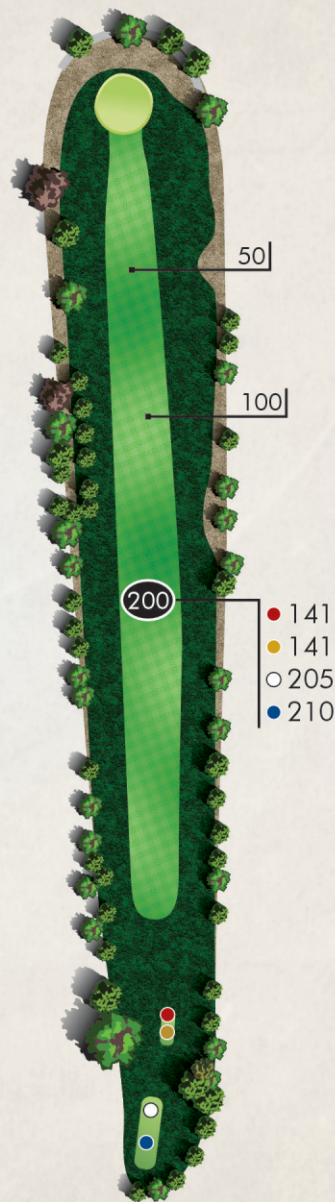

This hogback fairway is hard to find as it repels tee shots toward thick stands of trees to either side. The approach is to a fairway-level green that is the most undulating on the course.

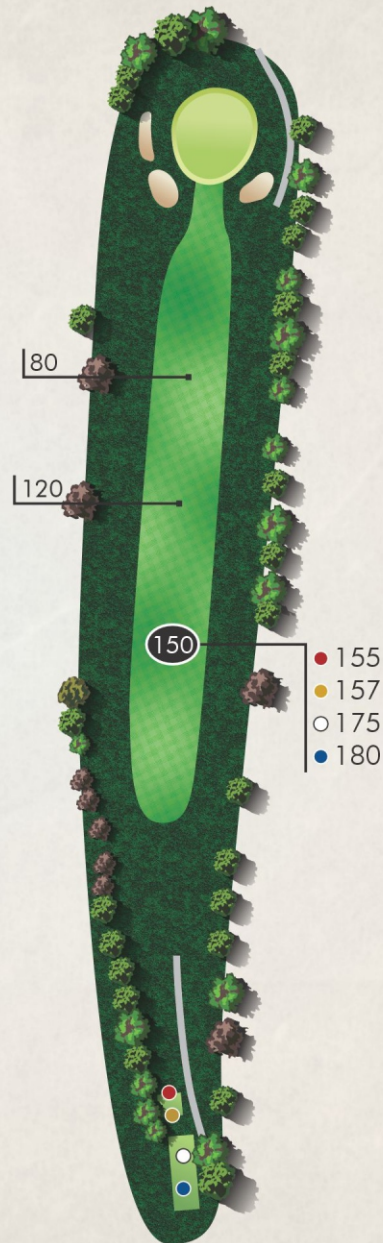

A classic “parkland style” par 4 with out of bounds left and trees right. The approach is uphill from a valley to a green protected both left and right by sand. The green doesn’t look like it slopes much ... until you’re above the pin.

The shortest par 3 is guarded by bunkers right and a trap and sharp falloff left. The green slopes gently from back to front.

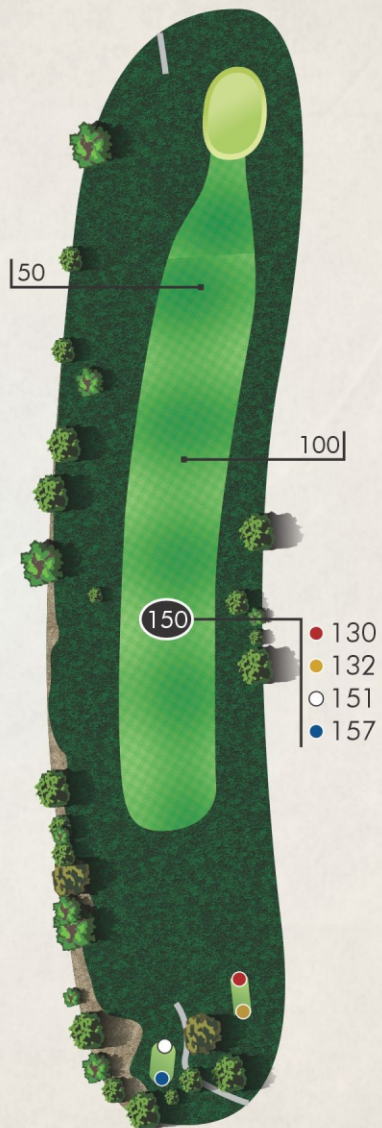

The shortest par 4 is uphill all the way and finding the fairway is paramount. Right is the worst miss. The green is the most severely pitched on the course, sloping dramatically from back to front. The only "safe" miss on the second shot is short. Before you head to the 8th tee, turn around and look at the stunning panoramic view of DuBois from the highest point on the course.

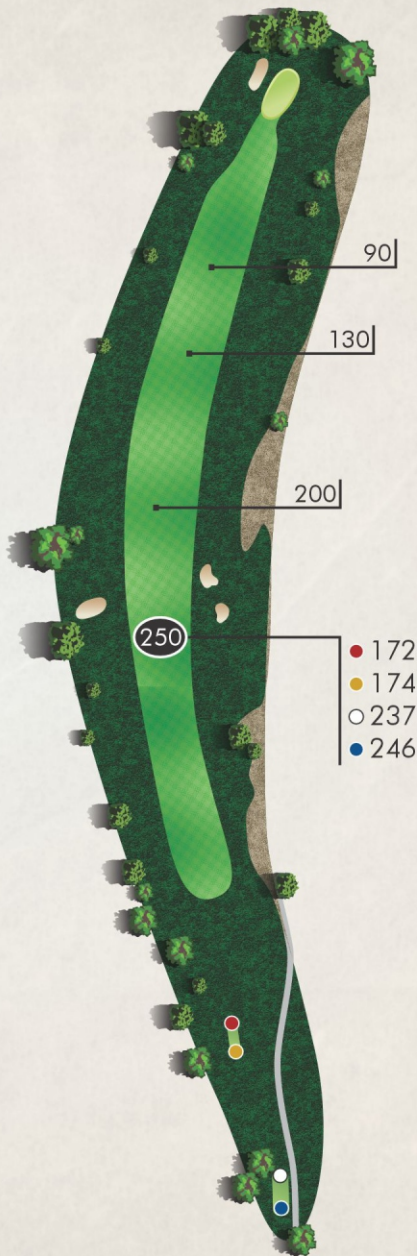

Let the big dogs eat. Once the blind, downhill tee shot avoids sand in the landing area left and right, players have a green light for a go at the green on this short par 5. A bunker on the left guards the gently sloping green. A genuine birdie chance.

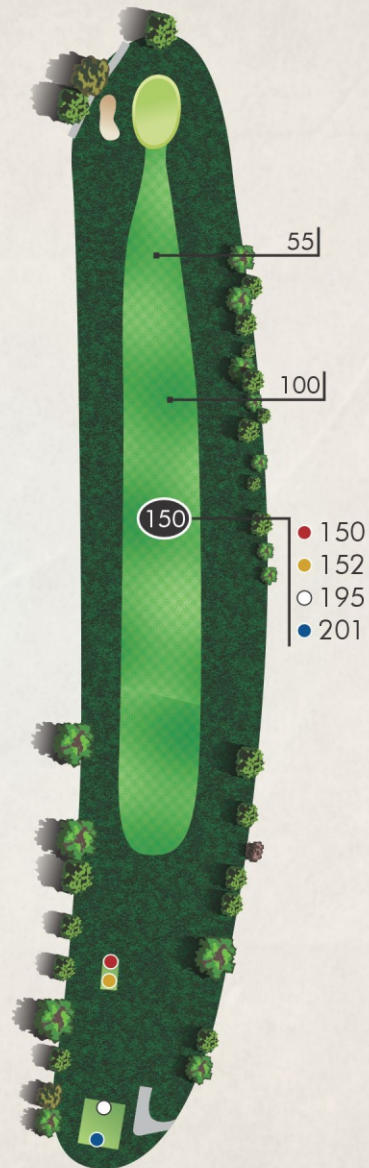

Most tee shots pitch into the slope of a hill but the hole still plays short. Trees guard the right side of the fairway. The often blind second shot is hit to a green guarded on the left by a yawning bunker... and out of bounds beyond.

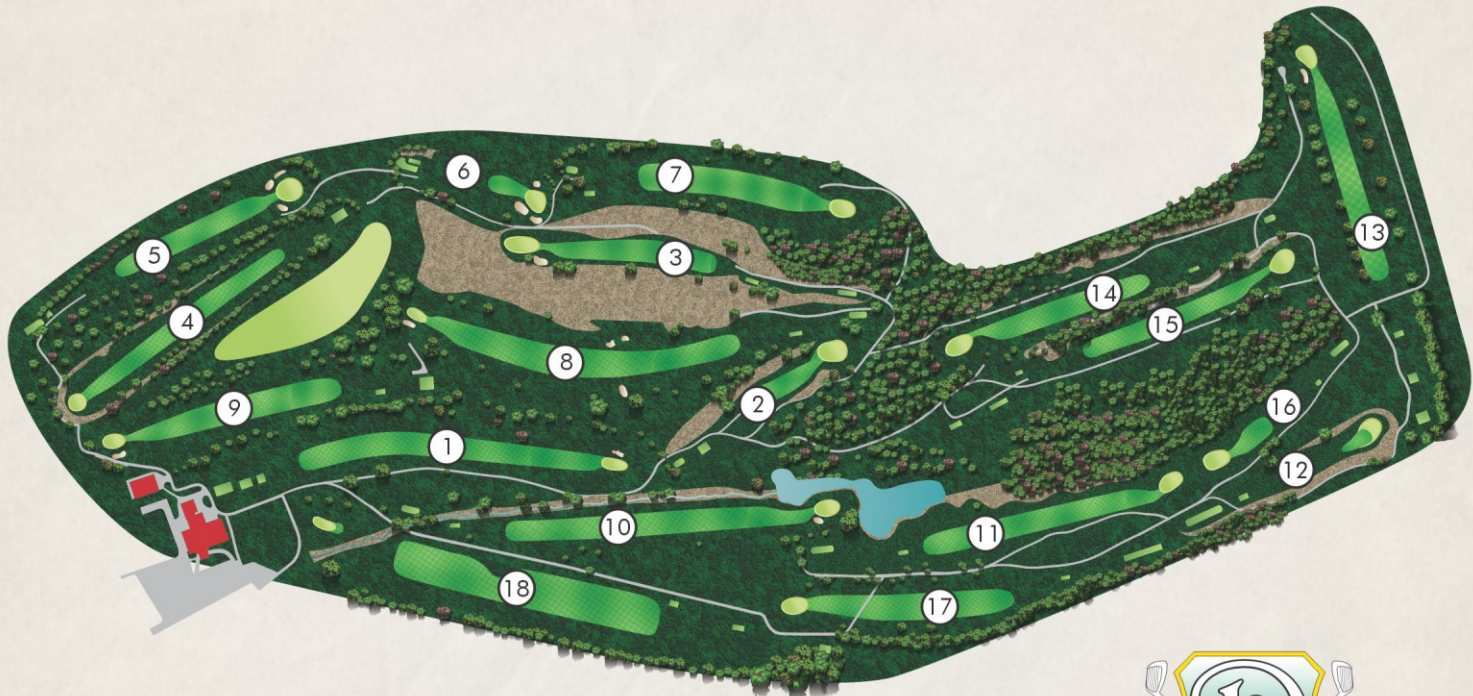

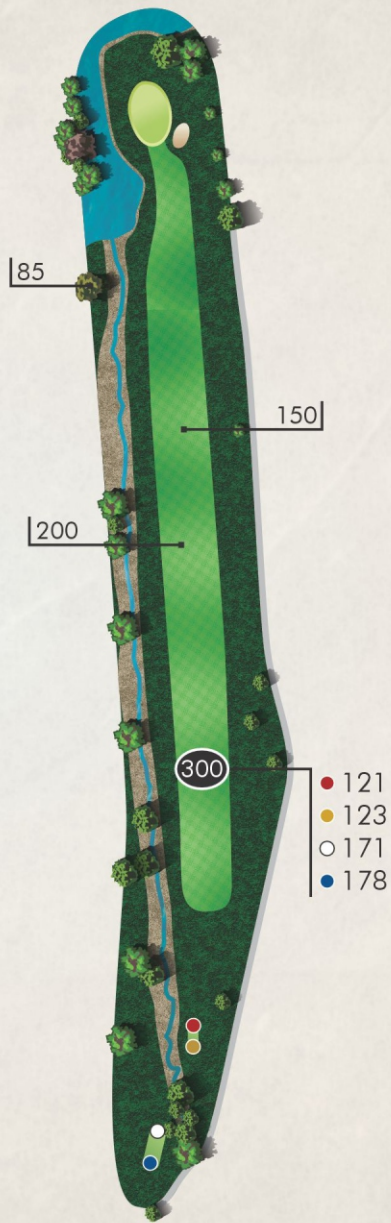

HOLE TEN



A relative breather to start the back side, which is one of the most demanding nine holes in west-central Pennsylvania. A lateral hazard snakes its way down the left side of the fairway, forcing many tee shots to the right. From there, have a go at the green... but stay out of Lake Juniata to the left.

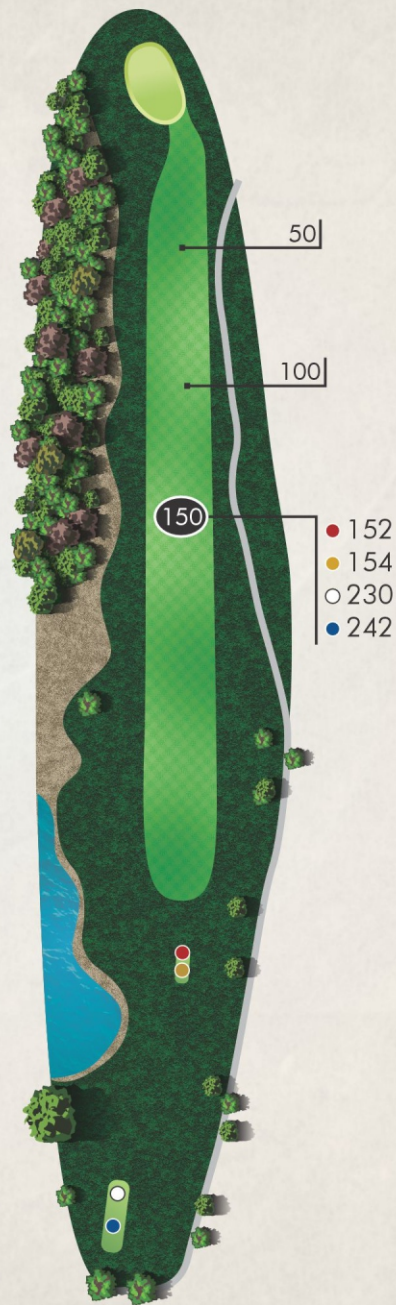

HOLE ELEVEN



The start of as testing a stretch of golf as there is in the area. Lake Juniata, a tributary stream and dense woods guard the left side of the landing area. A short or medium-iron approach is hit to a devilish green that slopes severely from right to left and back to front. Missing the green right is jail.

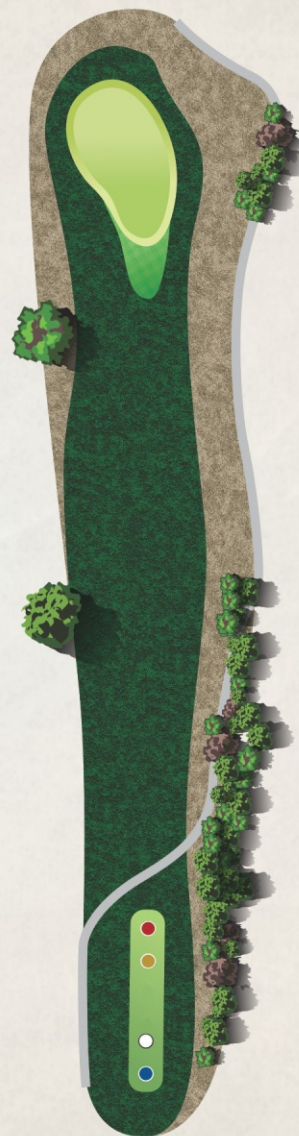

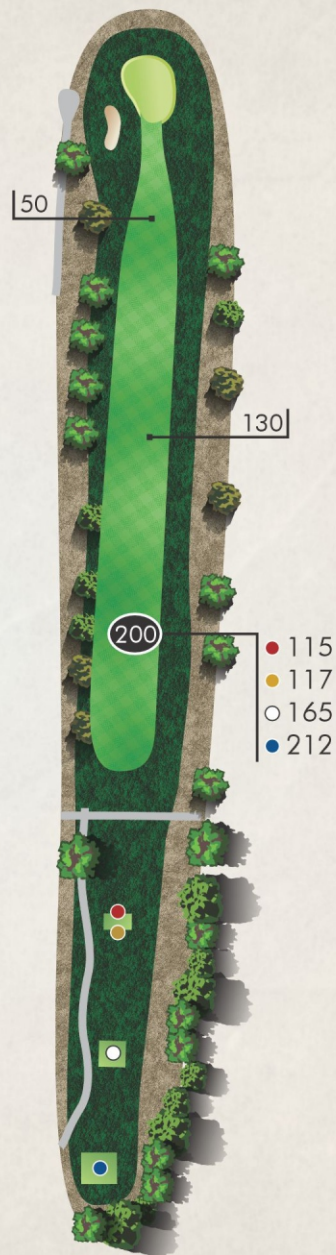

The first of a Terrible Triangle of rugged par 4s. A downhill tee shot through a corridor of sentinel trees is followed by a long uphill approach to a steeply pitched green guarded on the left by sand. No bargain here.

The middle leg in the triangle calls for a blind tee shot that favors the right side of a fairway that slants severely to the left into a tunnel of trees. A short second shot must stay below the pin position on a green that slopes severely from back to front.

HOLE FIFTEEN



One of the toughest drives on the course. The tree-lined fairway slopes dramatically to the right, where rough and more trees await. The approach shot is best played short and left of the green, which slopes more than it looks. Don't miss right.

A par 3 that plays much tougher than it looks, with a middle- or long-iron or even fairway wood to a sloping green guarded by a steep embankment right. Missing anywhere but short leaves a devilish pitch shot.

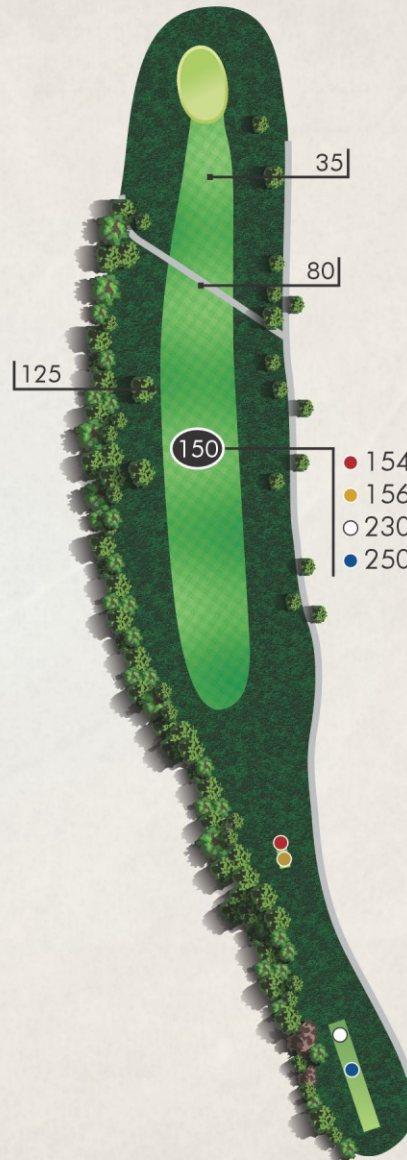

Tee shots must favor the left side of a fairway that falls sharply to the right. A medium length approach from a sidehill lie is hit to a green that slopes gently from back to front.

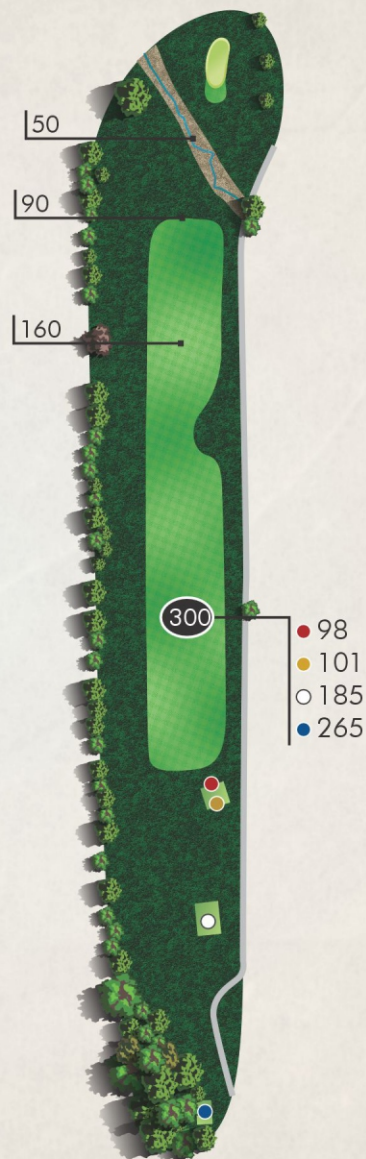

HOLE EIGHTEEN



Two big hits through one of the widest fairways anywhere are the best bet to set up the third shot at the home hole. Pay attention to that creek that meanders diagonally across the fairway about 80 yards short of the green, which is very narrow and guarded by mounds left.
